Thank you for your e-mail.

The abatement company for the work at the old High School is Commonwealth Contracting Services (CCS) out of Brockton. It is the same company that did the abatement work in the old gym prior to that demolition work in August 2009.

We understand your concerns with dust control. The Project Team has emphasized the need to perform proper dust control during the demolition and front site work. The General Contractor, Demolition Contractor, and Site Contractor are aware of the concerns and have stated that fire hoses and water trucks will be used to control the dust. Compass will be monitoring these efforts to ensure that proper measures are put in place and maintained throughout the work.

We will follow up with the street sweeping company regarding efforts to minimize the dust created by those efforts as well.

My name is Kerry Marino and I live on Nichols Street. With the completion of the new school right around the corner, I would like to address a few concerns I have with the demolition of the old building.

My first concern/question has to do with the asbestos abatement. Would you kindly inform me of the company that is going to perform the abatement? I have questions regarding their procedures and time frame.

I have a concern regarding the demolition of the old building and the intentions of controlling the dust from the demolition. When the gym was taken down, we were told that hoses were going to be used to control the dust. Whenever I drove by the school during this phase, the only hose I saw was one garden hose and it didn't put a dent in the dust control. I would like to request at this time that the committee commit to a better way of controlling the dust from the demolition of the school. On that same topic, the street sweeper that routinely swept Nichols Street and surrounding streets near the high school didn't use water when sweeping, leaving the dust to fly everywhere. Please use sweepers that disperse enough water to keep the dust from becoming airborne.
