<b>Grade</b>	9
<b>Topic</b>	Team Building/Ground Rules/ Favorite thing so far about High School and/or Biggest Challenge or Concern
<b>Goal</b>	<p><b>Goal</b> for the person/s running the advisory:</p> <p>To learn the names of your advisory students. To learn a little something about each one of them. To establish ground rules for your advisory.</p> <p><b>Goal</b> for the students:</p> <p>To learn each other's names and get acquainted. To be able to share their high school experience up to this point.</p>
<b>Activities/ Procedures</b>	<p>1. Print one copy of the handout for each student in your advisory. (Facilitators may participate as well.) Distribute icebreaker handout to students.</p> <p>2. Give the students 2 minutes to circulate and write the first and last name of the student who can answer yes to a question in the box.</p> <p>The person with the most boxes completed in two minutes wins.</p> <p>(They must have the First and Last name of the student written down.)</p> <p>3. Ask students to share with the group, their first and last name, one interesting fact about themselves and a high and low about high school up to this point.</p>
