

ReadiStep Overview

General Details:

- All freshmen will take the ReadiStep test on Wednesday, October 15th.
- ReadiStep measures students' skills as they relate to college & career readiness. It provides students with an understanding of their strengths and identifies areas for improvement. It also provides students with exposure to material covered on a more high-stakes test.
- Bring a calculator!
- Test results will be returned and reviewed by a guidance counselor when the scores come in.

ReadiStep Format/Content:

- Total duration of test: 2 hours (40 minutes per section)
- Three multiple-choice sections – reading, writing, and math (no essay or student-produced response questions)
 - Reading Skills – Reading passages and sentence completion
40 minutes – 45 questions
 - Writing Skills – Identifying errors and improving grammar & usage
40 minutes – 50 questions
 - Math Skills – Arithmetic operations, algebra, geometry, statistics, & probability
40 minutes – 36 questions (18 with calculator, 18 without calculator)
