Five Year Budget Projections


Background


- Both the Town and Schools have dug deep to produce projected budget needs for the next 5 year
- The School Department has created 2 sets of projections- one with expanding programs and one that is designed to retain the status quo
- These projected shortfalls are based on revenue and shared cost projections from town wide discussions at the BBC
- Please keep in mind that projections are an educated guess based on what we know now

Assumptions

- Teacher salaries 2.5% as well as step increases
- Circuit Breaker offset at 1.8 Million and increasing by 2.5% per year
- Snow and Ice used actuals from FY18
- Library books- replaced
- Other Supplies in the "Level Services" were kept at the reduced numbers for FY19, where the "Adjusted" were increased to original requested in FY19

Reductions

- Challenged by previous budget reductions in that discretionary spending does not exist in our present budget
- A reduction of 1 million dollars is equal to approximately 16 teachers
- Eliminating Athletics would reduce the budget by \$664,000
- Eliminating Afterschool Fine Arts would reduce the budget by \$211,000
