Dear Parents/Guardians,

Dr. Mark Stone, D.M.D., the school dentist, will be in our building on September 30th and October 2nd to perform dental screenings. This service is available to Norwood school children in grades 1-6 and is provided by the Norwood Board of Health. This service includes an initial visual examination of the teeth performed at school. A toothbrush will be given to each child participating. There is no charge for this service.

Parents will be notified by mail following the initial exam if cleanings and sealants are recommended. Follow-up visits for cleanings and sealants are done during the school day at the Norwood Town Hall. Transportation to and from dental clinic is included. You will be notified in advance of your child's appointment date. This year sealants will also be offered to all children grades 1 through 6. This service is available even if you have dental insurance. It is a wonderful opportunity for increased cleanings and reinforcement of good oral hygiene.

The cost for cleanings is \$1.00 and the cost for sealants is \$1.00 per tooth.

This wonderful service offered by the Town of Norwood is a great opportunity for children to receive dental care or increased dental care. If you have any questions, please contact the Dental Clinic at 781-762-1240, ext 171.
