Based upon your child's performance on the WIDA Model test, your child will be placed in the ELL Program. S/he will be pulled out of their classroom twice a week to work with the ELL teacher.				
S/he will also take part in the Massachusetts ACCESS testing mid-winter and may receive pull – out services in subsequent years as well as classroom support from the English as a Second Language (ESL) teacher and Sheltered English Instruction in the mainstream classroom.				
Your child will be enrolled in the ELL Program until s/he can demonstrate competency in the mainstream classroom by being able to complete class work independently. Your child's scores on the ACCESS test and the Massachusetts Comprehensive Assessment System (MCAS) will also be considered in future years in the decision to exit your child from the ELL Program.				
As parents/guardians, you have a legal right to meet with the principal, classroom teacher and/or ESL teacher concerning your child's educational progress. In addition, you have the right to refuse ELL services upon written notification by:
