Spanish 5 Honors Curriculum Overview

Description (including primary objective and outcomes):

This course is designed as an alternative to Advanced Placement for students who wish to continue the study of Spanish. The course will continue to improve students' proficiency in the four skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing, as well as deepen their cultural understanding of the Hispanic world. There will be an emphasis on improving listening comprehension using authentic materials such as films, as well as extensive speaking practice. Readings will include newspaper and magazine articles as well as literary selections. Attention will also be given to improvement in writing. Emphasis will be on composition and conversation. Summer work is required and includes reading, writing, and the preparation of an oral presentation.

Learning Experiences:

Viewing and Listening of authentic feature length and short films in the target language, Summarizing of Movies, Actions and Characters, Interpreting content and change outcomes, Matching of Movie Synopsis and Movie Posters for the Pop Culture Experience, Making their own Movie Poster, Oral Presentations Hands-on activities, games, songs, group/partner work, role-plays, dialogues, language lab and computer lab use, online forums; video and audio projects.
