Level 2 Intermediate – Sports Media Track Overview

Description

The purpose of this course is to develop skills in sports media production and reporting. Students will develop skills in both remote truck and field production, with a focus on producing sports programming for broadcast on the Norwood Public Access television station.

Learning Experiences

- Students will learn skills in remote truck production including truck cameras, truck control room, field audio and field lighting.
- Students will use hands-on experiences to practice remote truck skills in a cooperative team environment.
- Students will practice on-camera skills such as anchoring and sports reporting.
- Students will practice the communication skills, both verbal and non-verbal, used in the live truck environment.
- Students will learn to write, produce, direct and edit sports television packages.
- Students will be exposed to the equipment involved in Electronic Field Production and Electronic News Gathering for sports, such as camcorders, microphones and computer-based editing systems.
- Students will produce live sports broadcasts, as well as contribute to *Mustang Magazine,* which will be broadcast to the Norwood community via NPA-TV.
- Students will work with professionals from the Norwood Public Access Television station on various sports projects broadcast via NPA-TV.
- Students will enter work and participate in regional, state and national broadcast competitions.
