
Wednesday June 21: Make Up for Students 8:15- 9:45/Early Release and Grades Due for Staff

Notes for Staff and Students:

- On 6/14, all students will attend an extended block for period 5b 5.0 credit classes will have an EOY assessment at this time, 2.5 credit courses will have a long block which teachers can use as they see fit in that class.
- For the other six periods in the end of year assessment schedule, students in 5.0 credit courses will need to attend. 2.5 credit courses will end prior to the early release assessment period.
- All grades during the end of year assessment period count towards term 4 grade.
- Make up assessments may be scheduled with teachers after 11:30 on 6/15, 6/16, or 6/20, and from 8:15 - 9:45 on 6/21.
- Each academic department will decide on a format for end of year assessment (presentation, activity, exam, in class project, in class assignment, etc.) and can consider alternatives to traditional exams.

School Counseling

You may want to consider registering for the <u>SAT</u> or <u>ACT</u>. These may be used in evaluating your application, but many schools will be test-optional for this next admissions cycle. Be sure to check the admissions website of each school to determine what they need. If you want to access free, online help, check out <u>Khan Academy</u>.

- If you get the chance this summer, stop by a college campus or two. This will help you figure out what you may want in a college campus environment. It will also help your counselor brainstorm a list of schools with you.
- If you are planning on a 2 or a 4 year college, your counselor will be working on your recommendation in the coming months.
- To help them write the best possible letter for you, it is helpful to complete a resume (a list of activities that you have been involved in high school.)

You can do this in <u>Scoir</u>- our new college search/application tool that we will be using throughout the college application process. We will be sharing more about Scoir in the coming weeks, be sure to check your email for your registration link.

YardArt 6/10-6/17


YardArt is this weekend June 10-17! Go for a walk or drive and check out of the wonders that Norwood residents have made! Here is a map of the participating locations:
