The Visual Arts Department is proud to announce that 11 students' artwork were chosen to be displayed in Massachusetts Art Education Association's statewide juried exhibition. Melissa Colella and Alexandra Murphy both won the Davis Category Award Piloted in 2018, the Amazing Emerging Artists Recognitions is a juried show for students in grades 9-12 whose art teachers are members of the Massachusetts Art Education Association (MAEA). ## **Course Registration**

It is hard to believe that we are already selecting courses for the next school year 2024-2025! In the beginning of March, students in grades 9-11 met with their school counselor to review their course selection and finalize choices for next year. We enjoyed meeting with all of our students and making a plan for the next school year. ## **Post-Secondary Planning meetings for Juniors and Families**

We are excited to begin the post-secondary planning process for juniors. It is time to start thinking about life after graduation from Norwood High School. We are here to help with whatever that plan might be including 2 and 4 year college options, career/technical training programs, job and career searches, and the military. If you are thinking about college, please add to "College I am Thinking About" in Scoir. If you need to reset your password, you should be able to do so on their site.

Beginning in mid-March, school counselors will be available for 30 minute appointments for meetings with students/families to discuss the process. If you are planning to take either the <u>SAT</u> or the <u>ACT</u>, be sure to register on their website. The next SAT is May 4th and the deadline for registration is April 19th. The next ACT is June 8th and the deadline for registration is May 3rd. Many schools are "test-optional" which means students can choose whether or not to submit their test scores. However, we are paying close attention to the trends, and some schools are bringing back the requirement of a standardized test. We encourage you to check the requirements of the schools of which you are interested.

If you are planning to visit colleges or universities during the next few weeks or upcoming April vacation, be sure to register on their website. Tours, information sessions, and open houses fill up quickly and will go to a waitlist.

## NameDrop

Apple has released a new feature, NameDrop, with their newest update. This feature allows your contact information to be shared more easily with phones that are near yours. This is useful and convenient in some instances, but it may seem a little *too* easy for others. **To turn OFF Name Drop (which is automatically enabled with recent updates), go to Settings > General > toggle off "Bringing Devices Together".**




