Mr. Alan Slater, Chairman of the Middle School Building Project, welcomed everyone to this evening's public forum at Norwood High School in the GSU Lecture Hall. He informed that a lot has happened since the last public forum. He informed that after a competitive process, W.T. Rich has been hired as the Construction Manager at Risk. Also, during the design development there has been a number of meetings with various committees and sports groups in Norwood to coordinate the project and bring them up to date on how the project will affect their activities.

Mr. Slater had the project team introduce themselves: -Bethany King, Senior Project Manager for W.T. Rich; -Justin Thibeault, Ai3 Architects; -Chase Terrio, Vertex, Town's Owners Project Manager; -Harvey Eskenas, W. T. Rich; -Tim Bonfatti, Vertex, Project Manager

Mr. Thibeault reviewed that the process for the new Middle School started in 2016-2017 and a Statement of Interest was generated in 2018. He informed that we are currently in the Module 6 phase:

-90% Submission; -Early Bid Package -100% Documents

Bethany King, Project Manager, said that on June 1st her crew will be on site preparing the area, putting in office trailers, adding pedestrian walk-ways, etc. She said that over the past few months, they have been meeting with the recreation department, youth sports programs and the fire department (emergency access) to get their buy-in to this plan.

Youth Sports Discussions Recap:

-Construction Schedule / dates -Sports Season Schedule / dates -Offline fields -When and how long? -Athletic Lights -Field Access -Temp storage during construction -Permanent storage once project is complete -Concessions Building

The new Middle School will open in September of 2025. Work will continue as demolition of the current Middle School will begin in the fall of 2023.
