TASC IS...

The TASC program is designed for students with significant behavioral, social and emotional needs. Primarily, students who exhibit a lack of impulse control and overt behaviors which interfere with the student's ability to attend and learn. These behaviors generally fall into one or more of the following

categories

- Social skills which fall below age appropriate levels
- High levels of anxiety related to academics or social situations
- Insufficient coping skills
- Jnability to appropriately control anger fear and sadness


Individual and group counseling is provided to enhance self-esteem improve social interactions, and work on the skills necessary to be integrated into the general mainstream classes.

ACADEMIC

- Academic instruction is individualized, relating the general education curriculum with appropriate accommodations and modifications designated by the student's IEP.
- Ongoing consultation between classroom teams and the TASC liaison takes place on a regular basis to best support students learning in inclusion classes.
