## **IMMUNIZATIONS**

## **Grades 7-12 Entry REQUIREMENTS**

## 2013/2014 School Year

- 3 Doses Hepatitis B Vaccine
- **4 Doses DPT /DTaP** (Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis) **Vaccine** (or ≥3 doses Td plus 1 dose of Tdap)
- 1 Dose of Tdap Vaccine for grades 7-10

  Tdap is not required for grades 11& 12 but is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED

  (in the case of a pertussis outbreak your child could be at risk for illness and/or exclusion from school)
- ≥3 Doses Polio Vaccine
- **2 Doses of MMR** (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) **Vaccine** for grades 7-9 (2 doses of measles, one dose of mumps and 1 dose of rubella is acceptable for grades 10-12)

PLEASE NOTE: First dose must be dated on or after 1st birthday.

2 Doses Varicella (Chicken Pox) Vaccine for grades 7-9

 (1 dose is acceptable for grades 10-12)

 Or a Physician Certified note of chicken pox disease or serological proof of immunity

PLEASE NOTE: First dose must be dated on or after 1st birthday.

- A Physical Examination is required of all children within 12 months prior to entrance or during the first year after entrance to school. It is also required every three to four years (Grades K,4,7,10)
- **TB Test** If a student has a Primary Care Physician, it is up to the PCP to determine if a TB test or risk assessment, if necessary.

If a student does not have a Primary Care Physician, the school nurse, under the guidelines of the School Physician, may do a risk assessment and refer the student to the Norwood Board of Health if necessary.
