# Insider's Spain

JUL 8, 2013: OVERNIGHT FLIGHT Depart from the USA.

JUL 9, 2013: BARCELONA Arrive in Barcelona, once an important city under the Crown of Aragón, and now the capital of Catalonia. The rest of the day is free to explore. (D)

JUL 10, 2013: BARCELONA In the morning a panoramic city sightseeing tour with a local guide introduces you to Barcelona.
